# How to reduce your unnecessary and inconvenient door costs caused by wind damage

A common problem businesses experience at this time of the year is damaged doors due to very strong winds. Strong winds blow doors out of their tracks and sometimes rip them completely in two so what's left of the door is flapping about in the wind, leaving a wide opening for heat loss and uninvited guests.

Unfortunately, the laws of nature cannot be controlled but there are preventative measures available to you to help bring down those costs. Your roller shutter doors can be "Wind Locked": this is where the normal sidetracks are replaced with wind locked sidetracks.

Weather seals can also be applied to your doors.

Wind lock sidetracks have a different profile to the standard sidetracks and the door curtain is then modified to incorporate a different kind of end lock, which "locks" the curtain into the sidetracks so the risk of the roller shutter door being blown out of its tracks is reduced. Weather Seals on the other hand are multi-functional: they are used for keeping out cold draughts as well as a rodent deterrent. The seals are available in brush strip or rubber and help prevent unwanted draughts coming through the bottom of your doors.

Doors are most at risk of being damaged when the door is moving so when the strong winds are about, try to minimise the use of your doors. Personnel doors, especially with glass, can also be at risk of being blown off their hinges and the glass shattering. Just be aware of the winds outside.

If your business wants to reduce risks of wind damaged doors, wind lock your existing roller shutter doors, or change your door to a wind locked roller shutter door: Not only can this preventative measure be provided but these doors come with the option of weather sealing as well to ensure everything that is physically possible is done to help reduce wind damage and heat loss costs.
